Club Constitution Re-Registration

As you are no doubt aware, the rules regarding Incorporated Society's have changed, and we are required to update the Clubs Documentation to reflect this new landscape. A Working Group was formed to guide the club through this reformation process.

As part of this upgrade, we are required to have a constitution that meets specific requirements. Our existing constitution could not support the changes required so a new document has been prepared, and this was issued to the membership via email for their perusal on the 17th April 2025.

That revision was the first draft, that places us somewhere near where we need to be. Membership input is now invited to fine tune this document making it more reflective of the memberships views. As part of this process, we are asking club members to review this proposal, making comments, prior to it being submitted to a Special General Meeting for adoption.

Members are hereby formally invited to make submissions, detailing changes they feel are required to make this document more reflective of the clubs needs:

Prior to Making A Submission

- 1. Members are encouraged to engage with the Working Group (WG) to discuss aspects of the proposed constitution that concerns them, to obtain answers to queries, and to gain an understanding on the reasoning behind the documents contents. However, having such discussions does not constitute making a submission.
- 2. The WG will make themselves available to club members to discuss this proposal at the following:
 - a) Track Running Day 18th May
 - b) Club Meeting 22nd May
 - c) Track Running Day 1st June
 - d) Committee Meeting 5th June

Making A Submission

- 1. To be valid, a submission must be delivered/emailed received by the Secretary, no later than 5:00 pm on the 8th June.
- 2. The Secretary will email a confirmation to the submitter acknowledging the receipt of their submission.
- 3. All submissions must be in writing. A printed copy of the Draft Constitution marked up with hand written notes would suffice. But we need to know exactly what you want changed, and precisely what you are proposing.
- 4. All submissions must clearly identify the clause number to which the submission refers.
- 5. All submissions must include the submitters name, phone number, and a contact email address.
- 6. At this stage we are not interested in syntax and grammatical errors. These will be corrected in a separate process once the wording and content of the document has been finalised.
